



Teen Feed is excited to announce the launch of our new Youth Access to Care (YAC) program

The first of its kind in Washington State, the YAC program helps at-risk youth navigate complicated healthcare systems to make positive choices and live healthy lives. Two new YAC Coordinators are trained to **link youth with health insurance, match them with sensitive providers, and advocate for them** at their appointments. The YAC project at Teen Feed is being offered through generous support from the Pacific Hospital Preservation & Development Authority

Eligibility Requirements:

- YAC will be offered to all homeless and at-risk youth ages 13-25 in King County beginning August 15, 2014.

Referral Process:

- Youth can self-refer to YAC
- Youth can connect with our YAC Youth Health Coordinators
- **YAC will accept referrals for health coordination services from all King County youth providers.**
