The Coalition on Homelessness' Youth & Young Adults Committee is looking for Peer Leaders for our Youth Advocacy Summit!

The Youth Advocacy Summit is a two day event for homeless youth and young adults to learn advocacy skills, talk about what issues are most important to them, and then meet with City and County elected officials and staff to talk about those issues. **We are looking for six youth to be peer leaders**. If selected, you will work in a team with experienced Peer Leaders who currently work at youth service agencies to lead Youth Summit.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 26 years of age or younger, and have experienced homelessness or currently be homeless.
- Must be able to work in a team with other people.
- We are looking for young people who want to be leaders.
- Interest in advocacy a plus.
- NO EXPERIENCE NECCESARY. *We will provide training.*

COMPENSATION:

- Peer Leaders will be paid a total of a \$75 stipend. \$25 for completing a pre-Summit training and planning meeting on September 18th from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. at Seattle Youth Ministries (in the U-District). \$50 for completing both days of the Youth Advocacy Summit: September 22-23 from 8:30 a.m. – 4 p.m. at Seattle City Hall.
- Training in advocacy, leadership, team building, and group facilitation. Will receive a certificate of completion— a great experience to list on your resume. Food provided at training.
- FUN opportunity to have your voice heard and help other young people have their voices heard!
