

# PAST FELONY CONVICTION?

Voting rights are now restored immediately upon release from prison, even if you're still under community supervision or owe any court fines or fees.

Regardless of your release date, if you are not currently incarcerated, a citizen over the ages of 16, and a resident of Washington State for at least 30 days then you are eligible to register to vote, cast your ballot, and make your voice heard.
