Hopelink's Family Development Program helps families achieve greater stability and self-sufficiency. Partner with a case manager to create a personalized goal plan, focusing on the strengths and potential of your family. Goals can center around increasing income, education, legal issues, health resources, parenting, and more. Every family is different! While FDP is not a housing or financial assistance program, your case manager can help you navigate the housing system and connect you to resources.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- You can participate in case management for up to 24 months.
- Your case manager can meet you out in the community or at your home.
- The Family Development Program can not provide or guarantee housing.
- If Hopelink is closed to the public, you can still meet regularly with your case manager over the phone or video call.

WHO IS THE FAMILY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR?

- You live, work, or go to school in Hopelink's service area (North and East King County).
- You have at least 50% custody of at least one child under age the age of 18.
- You can commit to engaging regularly with your case manager.
- Your annual household income is at or below the amounts listed:
