Seattle Proposition 1 renews and modifies Seattle's Transportation benefit District for 6 years. This .15% sales tax generates critical investments, continuing transit service that essential workers, kids, low-income neighbors, disabled people, and people of color count on now more than ever.

Invests in Transit Service.

Prop. 1 maintains critical investments in the frequent transit network and generates 150,000 hours of bus service every year.



This provides essential access to jobs, services, and opportunities.

Transit is essential.

While thousands of people are working from home during the pandemic, 1 out of 3 essential workers in Seattle relies on Metro. We must ensure bus service remains open, safe, and dependable for the essential workers we all count on.



Support for West Seattle, Georgetown, and South Park.

Targetted transit investments help offset the impacts of the West Seattle Bridge closure.



Transit supports equity.

Seattle is an expensive city, and for many who can't make ends meet the cost of getting around is a big problem. Prop. 1 provide free transit passes for seniors, people with low-incomes or disabilities, and public school students so all kids have equal access to transportation.



Free transit passes for students and low-income seniors.

Prop. 1 gives a free transit pass to every Seattle public school student, low-income seniors, and people who count on transit most.



Builds a new generation of transit riders.

Thousands of kids rely on Metro buses to get to school or get around. We have to ensure that our bus service is ready when we can reopen, and this measure will not only ensure Metro Bus service is operating, but will provide all Seattle students with free bus passes so all children, especially those from low income families who are most in need, can get around and get back to school.
